- The Tuition fees for stays longer than 1 term include the cost of school uniform, a basic stationery pack, workbooks, sports fees, a class photo (Term 1 only) and an ID card.
- Students buy or bring their own flat black lace-up leather (or leather-look) shoes and plain black rain jacket, either a puffer-style or a lightweight plain black jacket.
- Students who come for a short term stay can either wear their school uniform from their own school or they can hire a Tawa College uniform.
- The cost of any subject-related school trips and the school formal dance (Year 12 and 13 only) is not included in the Tuition fees.
- Students all require Insurance which can be obtained through the College.
- International students sitting NCEA qualifications pay NZQA International examination fees.
